

Minutes of the ISPRS WG II/5 committee meeting

During the 3rd International Workshop on 3D Geo-Information in Seoul, South Korea on 13th November 2008 a committee meeting of ISPRS WG II/5 'Multidimensional and mobile data models' took place. At the meeting were present: Alias Abdul Rahman (Chair), Christopher Gold (Co-chair) and Pawel Boguslawski (Secretary).



The main topic of this meeting was need of good description for 3D modelling in particular for topology in these models. Currently there are many different ways of 3D models description. Very often it is very difficult to join two different models because of lack of one uniform standard. We think this is a good time to start work on it, and initiated an interest group on 3D topology. We would like to encourage people from other research teams to cooperate in this matter. We had a positive feedback from the participants of the conference. For this reason we decided to allow people sharing their papers, presentations and ideas in one place.
